

With an unusual start of 2020, the Amery Fall Festival Committee has had to make several difficult choices. Some our choice. Some choices decided by others.

Here's a quick summary of what has changed, etc:

(1) Our festival will no longer run Thursday to Sunday, rather will be a single day event held on Saturday (September 19th 2020). Essentially it is now, "Amery Fall FestiDAY 2020"!

(2) The location of the "main" events has changed from the "big tent" to Michael Park / Danielson Stage.

(3) Some events have been shrunk or eliminated – there will not be an arts & crafts fair, quilt show, carnival, etc.

(4) Some events have been modified – parade has been shrunk to 1 hour in length, food vendor area adjusted to solely include food trucks, coronation and music event locations have been adjusted, etc.
