November 3 Presidential Election

- The polls are located at 118 Center Street.
- The polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.
- For the safety of voters and election staff, polling places will be following Covid- 19 protocols including sanitizing and requiring the use of face coverings.

Absentee Voting: Any qualified, registered elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. To obtain an absentee ballot you may:

In-Person: Personally come to the City Clerk's office to cast an absentee ballot October 20th through October 30th between the hours of 8am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. The deadline for voting an in-person absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is 5:00 p.m. on October 30th.

By Mail: You can make a request in writing and we will mail you an absentee ballot. The written request must include your voting address within the City of Amery, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. State Law currently requires a photo ID in order to receive a ballot. Please include a copy of your valid photo ID with your request. You can also print our Absentee Ballot Request form. If you use this form, remember to sign and date the form prior to submitting it by mail. The deadline for submitting an absentee request by mail is 5:00 p.m. on October 29th.

Email: You may also make a request by email containing the information as stated in number 2 (above) and attach a copy of your photo ID to the email to: patty.bjorklund@amerywi.gov

The deadline for voting an in-person absentee ballot in the Clerk's Office is 5:00 p.m. on October 30th.

Ballots that have been mailed to voters include a postage paid return envelope. *Ballots must be returned to the City Clerk's Office by 8 p.m. on Election Day. Any ballots received after 8 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted.*

Important Notice to Utility Customers

All water and sewer bills must be paid in full by 4:30 PM on **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20th, 2020**. Any bills left unpaid will be placed on your Real Estate Tax bill with a 10% penalty added. Please pay your bill promptly.

Anyone who is going to be gone for the winter or for an extended period of time **MUST** contact City Hall before you leave so that we can make a note of it and not bill you for garbage during the time you are gone. You will **NOT** receive credit if you call after the billing has been done.

NO IN-PERSON TAX COLLECTIONS

Due to COVID-19 concerns, we will not be taking in-person payments for taxes or dog licenses. Tax payments **MUST** be mailed or dropped in one of the City's three (3) payment drop boxes. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like a receipt or dog license. Stay Informed All Year Round! There are many ways to get updates from the City of Amery. In addition to following Amery on Facebook, you can subscribe to notices on the city's website at www.amerywi.gov and register by clicking the *Notify Me* icon.

FIRE HYDRANTS: If you have a fire hydrant near your property, the City would greatly appreciate any assistance in removing snow from around it, if you are able.

CITY LANDFILL: There will be no leaf pick-up. The landfill is open the 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month from 9am to Noon. **The landfill will close for the season after November 7th.** The City landfill will only take clean lumber, brush, leaves, and compost as well as concrete and asphalt from city residents. **All leaves must be removed from their bags at the landfill.** Other larger items, such as appliances and furniture should be taken to Waterman's Sanitation located at 663 85th Street, for disposal or call (715) 268-6471 for more information. There will not be a Christmas tree pick-up this year. The landfill will be open the first week in January for you to dispose of your tree yourself.

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS go into effect

November 1st through April 15th. There will be no parking on City streets from **2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.** Please make off-street parking arrangements for winter now.

Drop off a copy of your dog's rabies certificate and a check in one of the 3 drop boxes **after** December 31st to renew your pet's license! Licenses run from January 1st to December 31st. A copy of the rabies certificate from your veterinarian is **required** to obtain a license.

Spayed / Neutered - \$ 5.00
Unaltered / Intact - \$10.00

A Late Fee of \$5.00 per dog will be added after March 31st.

REMINDER: All dogs must be leashed within the City of Amery. You are responsible for keeping your dog on your property.
