

Amery Clean Lakes Program Update

STORMWATER PLANNING GRANT

\$45,150 grant \$20,350 match required (lake district)
Total project cost: \$64,500

Components: stormwater management plan, ordinance review and updates, financing mechanisms

Goal: ***Amery Lakes water quality is protected from degradation.***

Stormwater Management Plan

- ✓ Overviews existing conditions (storm sewer system, soils, land use)
- ✓ Estimates pollutant loading from various areas (subwatersheds)
- ✓ Recommends land management, ordinances, and public education
- ✓ Recommends structural practices

Stormwater Financing Mechanisms

- ✓ Options investigated, stormwater utility recommended
- ✓ Background work completed for stormwater utility

Stormwater Management and Erosion Control Ordinance

City requirements now consistent with Polk County
Costs to be paid via permit fees

LAKE PROTECTION GRANT

Expires December 31, 2010

\$200,000 grant \$67,000 match required (lake district and city)

Total project cost: \$267,000

City match provided in staff salaries or cash: \$8,000

Components: educational materials and delivery, residential and commercial runoff management Best Management Practices, Flag Pole Park engineering and installation

Status

Goal: *Amery residents and business owners understand the significance of storm water runoff and the importance of protecting water quality in Amery.*

Free technical assistance to residents and businesses

Free rain barrels to residents

Rain gardens, shoreline buffers, etc. 70% cost sharing in lakes watershed

Completed rain gardens: Cysewski, Anich, John, Bavin

Promotion: Garden club tour (08) rain garden parties (09)
